New Site Connects Adjunct Online Faculty with Ohio's Colleges and Universities

COLUMBUS, Ohio -- Matchmaking isn't usually done by The Ohio Learning Network, but a new website will connect part-time faculty looking to teach courses online with colleges and universities that wish to expand online course offerings.

The Adjunct Professor Exchange is a resource for faculty and institutions to meet the growing demand for online course offerings. The Exchange consists of two components. The first is a registry for faculty. Faculty interested in teaching online can register at the site to provide information including their areas of interest, geographic regions or institutions preferred, education, and experience.

The second component is a registry of available positions. Participating campuses have the opportunity to post available teaching positions on the site. Faculty who have registered at the site are able to search for positions that match their interests and backgrounds.

The Adjunct Professor Exchange was created as a service of the Ohio Learning Network (OLN), an organization that promotes and supports e-learning in the state of Ohio. OLN has 65 member colleges and universities and is a program of the Ohio Board of Regents. OLN does not hire or make recommendations about jobs or individuals.
